M&CA Completes Dining Room Renovation

Chicago, IL - Palos Community Hospital recently completed a major renovation project to their Dining Room and Dietary Department at its' Palos Heights, IL campus. The multi-phased project comprised the complete redesign and renovation of the existing dietary department including, public and private dining rooms, vending area, servery and kitchen. The 23,600 SF project was completed in multiple phases without disrupting dietary services to patients, staff and visitors and minimal impact on the day to day operations of the facility. A skylit, central open stair was designed to connect the lower level dining room with the first floor and to provide natural daylighting to the space. The expanded dietary spaces meet the service needs of the new Hospitaller Pavilion completed in 2013 and the renovation of the existing St. George Pavilion to be complete in 2017. M&CA worked closely with the design/construction team including Owner, Consultants, Contractor and Subcontractors in a design-assist approach to share information early in the schedule to provide a seamless transition during the construction process.
